



Year 3.4 Spelling – Monday 12th February 2024

Challenge 1

This week, the children are learning how to spell **contractions**. The apostrophe shows where the letter or letters would be if the words were written in full e.g. **did not – didn't**.

Contractions e.g. can't - cannot

- If **is** is part of the two words that make up the contraction, leave out the **i** and replace with an apostrophe e.g. **she is - she's, that is – that's**.
- If **not** is part of the two words that make up the contraction, leave out the **o** and replace with an apostrophe e.g. **have not – haven't, is not – isn't, could not – couldn't. Exception: will not – won't, can not – can't**.
- If **will** is part of the two words that make up the contraction, leave out the **wi** and replace with an apostrophe e.g. **I will – I'll, they will – they'll, we will – we'll**.

Apply the rules to these words: **he is, it is, does not, would not, is not, should not, do not, he will, you will, it will, she will**

Choose 5 of the examples and put them into a sentence.
