Challenge 1

This week, the children will be focusing on the below sounds.

Please make sure that you know the meaning of each word and not just how to spell it.

**ure (sure it's pure)
air (that's not fair)
are (care and share)**

It is important that your child looks carefully at their spelling when they have written a word containing these sounds, to decide if it *looks* right, especially when choosing which 'air' sound to use.

Examples:

sure pure cure secure picture nature adventure injure mixture

stairs chair hairy fair unfair hairband upstairs armchair repair
airport

care dare scare square share bare careful farewell beware compare
barefoot

Challenge:

Work together to practise writing these words making sure that you select the correct letters for the sound.
