



Year 3.4 Challenge 1 Spelling – Monday 4th March 2024

This week, the children are learning how to add a suffix ending where the root word changes.

ed, ing, er, est

Examples:

e.g. hike – hiking – hiker – hiked, nice – nicer – nicest.

Here the 'e' is dropped and then this suffix is added.

Activity 1

Apply the rule to these root words:

ride, hide, take, smile, love, drive, bake, come, like, decide

How many of these words can be written with 3 of the different suffix endings?

Activity 2

Can you spot any words in story books that follow this rule? Write these down and practise writing these words too.
