Challenge 1

This week, the children are learning how to spell words ending in –dge.

-dge

The letter j is never used for the ‘j’ **sound** at the end of English words.

Use **–dge** at the end of a one-syllable word, straight after the ‘short’ vowel sound.

e.g. badge, edge, bridge, fudge. Exception: college.

Challenge: Use the ‘Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check’ method to learn your spellings.
Have 2 or 3 tries.

Look → Say → Cover → Write → Check
