



Year 3.4 Spelling – Monday 24th June 2024

This week, the children are revising adding the suffix *ly* to words ending in *y*, *le* and *ic*:

They will consider how the suffix will change the spelling of the words the rules are:

- Words ending in *y* change the *y* to *i*.
- Words ending in *le* take off the *e*.
- Words ending in *ic* add *ally*.

Examples: happily, wobbly, gently, dramatically, prettily, frantically etc.

National Curriculum Words:

The words this week are:

Island, knowledge. Learn, length, library.

Task

Challenge 1

Choose a root word from this list and then, using the rules above, write the word including the suffix: happy, pretty, easy, sleep, greedy, clumsy, angry, gentle, simple, humble, noble, wobble, basic, frantic, specific, dramatic.

Examples: specific becomes specifically; happy becomes happily; wobble becomes wobbly.

Challenge 2:

1. Please practise your spellings on J2E Spell Blast at J2E.com
2. Write sentences using the examples above.

Example: The hungry sheep ate the grass greedily.
