Reception to Year 6 Pupils - Autumn & Spring Terms

Grey Trousers/Skirt or Pinafore
White Shirt (tucked in)
Eastbury Farm Tie (elasticated in Reception & KS1)
Green branded Eastbury Farm Jumper or Cardigan
Grey Socks or Tights
Black Shoes

Reception to Year 6 Pupils - Summer Term (optional)

Grey Shorts, White Short Sleeved Shirt (tucked in) - ties must still be worn but may be removed on hot days
or
Green & White Gingham Dress, White Socks

Nursery Pupils

Grey Tracksuit Bottoms or Leggings
White or Green Short or Long Sleeved Polo Shirt (branded Green polo shirts are available)
Green branded Eastbury Farm Jumper
Trainers or suitable footwear

P.E. Kit (all pupils*)

Green branded Eastbury Farm Drawstring P.E. Bag
Green Eastbury Farm Shorts
White Short or Long Sleeved Polo Shirt – (branded or unbranded)
White Socks
Trainers
In Year 3/4 only: One piece swimming costume or trunks, a towel and a swimming hat are required for swimming lessons
For the colder months:
Black Tracksuit Bottoms or leggings
Green branded Eastbury Farm Fleece Jacket
*A letter to the Class Teacher is required if a child is unable to participate in P.E. or swimming lessons

Forest School (Nursery & Reception)

Wellington Boots and Waterproofs are essential

Further Guidelines

- All uniform must be named, clean and in good repair
- Art aprons for all pupils are provided by the school (funded by EFSA)
- A school bag is required in Nursery, Reception and KS1 for transporting reading books, letters, lunch and water bottles to and from school. An optional green branded Eastbury Farm rucksack is available to purchase
- Children in KS2 may bring a school bag of their choice
- Water bottles must be transparent, re-usable plastic with a sports cap that can be closed easily
- Green branded Eastbury Farm baseball caps, legionnaire caps and sun hats are available to buy
- Nail varnish and make-up must not be worn and will be removed if worn. Nails must be kept short
- Long hair must be tied back using only green or black hair bands and clips. Large bows and hair accessories are not permitted
- Hairstyles must be neat, smart and appropriate for school. Patterns must not be shaved onto heads and hair must not be gelled into spikes or unusual shapes. Dyed hair is not permitted.
- Watches are allowed but must be removed for P.E. and swimming.
- If earrings are worn, they must be studs which must be removed or taped over for P.E. and swimming (parents must provide tape)

- No other jewellery is permitted
- The school respects cultural dress and the uniform may be modified accordingly in consultation with the Headteacher. Headscarves must be dark green.
- If any pupil arrives at school dressed inappropriately, the Headteacher reserves the right to send the child home to change
- School uniform is stored on site and can be purchased through EFSA and paid for via the School Gateway
