Roll a dice to make three digit add three digit calculations with regrouping. Put your largest numbers rolled at the top and smallest numbers at the bottom.

Can you include rhetorical questions, facts and the pronoun 'you'?

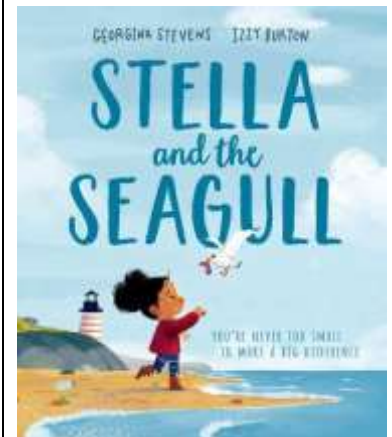
Year 4:
