Secondary Transfer - What is it?



Secondary transfer is the transition from Primary School to Secondary School.

The SW Herts* Secondary Transfer tests are similar to the 11+ tests used by some independent schools and Grammar schools.

The SW Herts test (VR & Maths) does **NOT** have a pass mark. The results are used as a guide when selecting schools.

The SW Herts test results allow schools to be **selective** with their intake each year.



* Buckinghamshire tests are similar. Bucks does have a pass mark

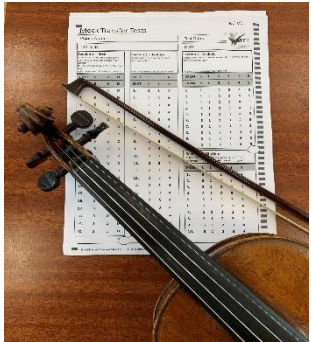

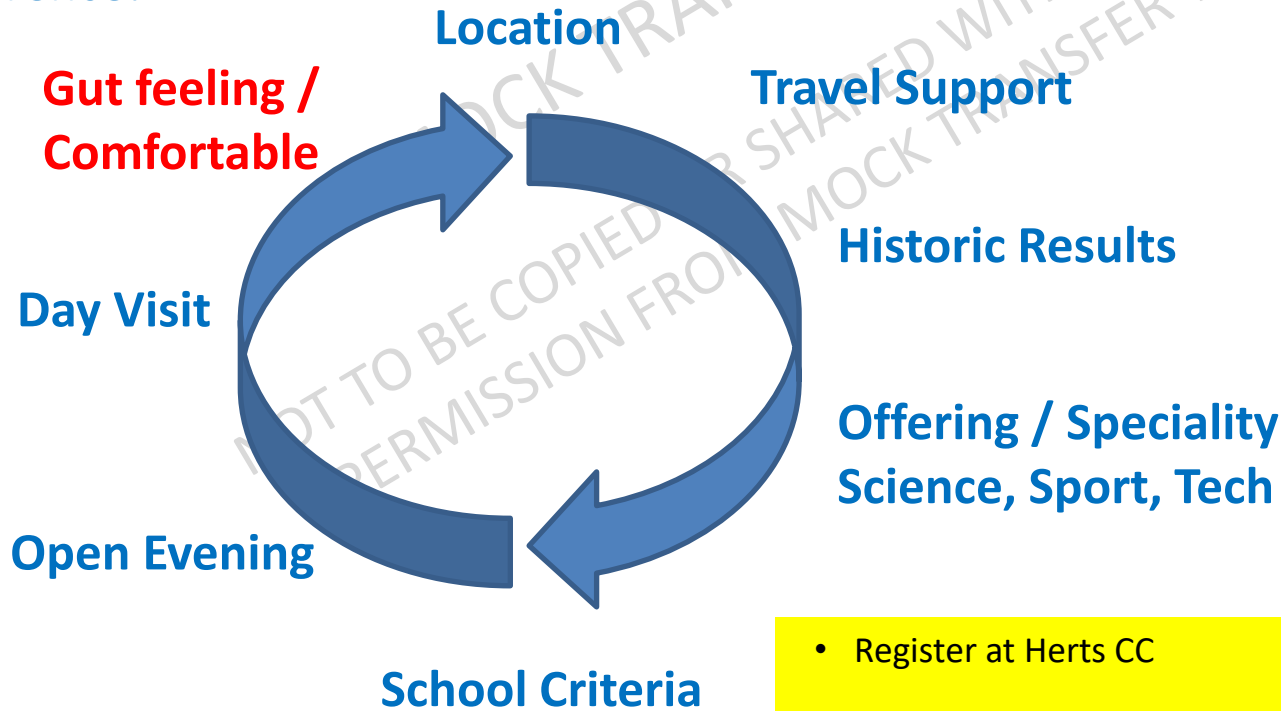

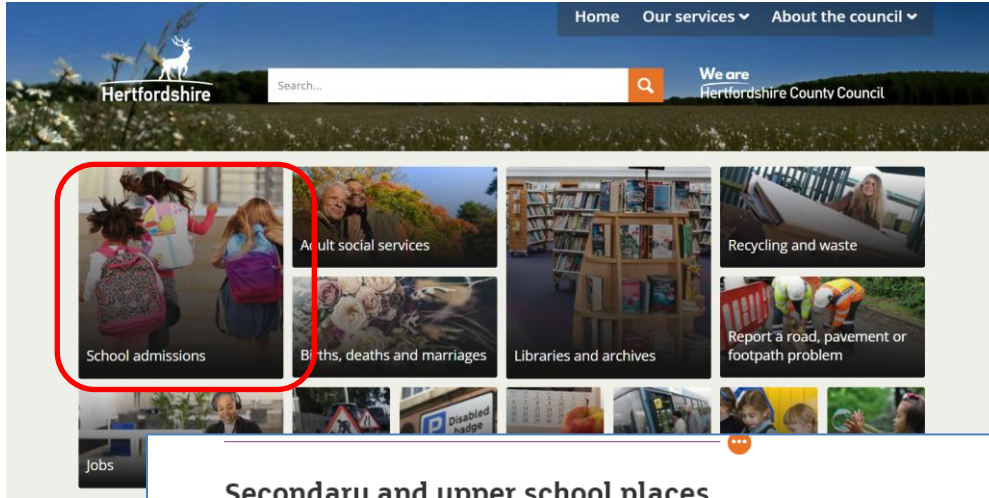

Accepting a School & Continuing Interest



- National allocation day - **March 2nd**
- Parents are able to Accept or Reject a school place.
- There is some movement over the initial period.
- Students will be automatically placed on the CI list for all schools originally ranked higher than the schools that were actually offered. (**R1. 23rd – 27th March , R2. 27th Apr – 1st May**)
- Parents may remove their child from the CI list if they wish or remain until the 23rd July. (In year application afterwards)
- **Appeals** – parents may appeal, however the appeal case must be strong and specific to the school for which you are appealing. [Hertfordshire appeals process](#)

The Consortium is a group of seven partially selective schools in Southwest Hertfordshire, consisting of:

- Croxley Danes School (Music only)
- Parmiters School
- Queens School
- Rickmansworth School
- St Clement Danes School
- Watford Grammar School for Boys
- Watford Grammar School for Girls

Registration for Secondary Transfer for September 2026 is now closed. No late registrations will be accepted.

Summary of the Secondary Transfer test process:

1. **Important Dates:** Application and testing dates are crucial; be sure to check the [calendar](#) for deadlines.
2. **Eligibility:** Ensure your child is eligible for the Consortium Schools before registering. If ineligible, you may be testing unnecessarily and the application may be discarded by the school.
3. **Parent Portal:** Registration for tests opens on April 1, 2025. Late registrations won't be accepted. Log in regularly to check updates, results, and test allocations. Be aware that emails may end up in spam, so check the portal often.
4. **Test Registration:** Only one registration is allowed per child. Make sure all details and tests are accurate before submitting as changes cannot be made once the registration period ends.
5. **Account Setup:** Create an account using your email and secure password to register your child. Confirm registration by activating your account via email.
6. **Special Consideration:** If your child requires extra time or support, upload the necessary documents from their school's SENDCo or Headteacher by June 6, 2025. Missing this deadline will result in placement on a reserve test day.
7. **Queens' School PE Test:** Only for applicants to Queens' School who have exceptional sporting aptitude and live within a specific catchment area. The test is on September 10, 2025.
8. **Communication:** Test Administrators will respond to emails within 48 hours during term time; responses may take longer during holidays.

Ensure you follow all procedures carefully and check the Parent Portal regularly for updates and announcements.
