



Year 3.4 Spelling – Monday 12th June 2023

Challenge 3

This week, the children will be focusing on the **four different ways** to make the same sound:

oo (poo at the zoo)
ew (chew the stew)
u-e (huge brute)
ue (blue glue)

It is important that your child **looks carefully** at their spelling when they have written a word containing any of these 'oo' sounds, to decide if it **looks** right. If unsure when practising, your child should write it using each sound and then select the one they think is correct. This will support your child's ability to apply their knowledge of the sound in their independent writing.

Examples:

oo (poo at the zoo)	ew (chew the stew)	u-e (huge brute)	ue (blue glue)
spoon	flew	use	tissue
shampoo	newest	attitude	argue
bedroom	chewing	include	statue
toothbrush	nephew	perfume	rescue
balloon	unscrew	volume	avenue

Challenge:

1. Work together to practise writing these words making sure that you select the correct letters for the sound.
2. Can you find words containing any of these sounds in a magazine or newspaper? Add these to your grid of words to practise.

The children will continue to learn and apply these sounds in writing throughout the week and will complete a short spelling test on **Friday 16th June 2023** where they will
