



Year 3.4 Spelling – Monday 8th January 2024

This week, the children are looking at the prefixes 'sub' and 'tele' which are added to the beginning of root words without any changes in spelling. Sub means "underneath," and tele means "far away,"

Examples: subway, submerge, subsoil, subterranean, telescope, television, telephone.
