



Year 3.4 Spelling – Monday 15th January 2024

This week, the children are looking at words where the sound [ʃ] normally spelt with “sh” is spelt with a “ch ” (mainly French in origin) or “s” or a “ss.”

Examples: chef, brochure, mission, sure, sugar, machine.
