



Year 3.4 Challenge 1 Spelling – Monday 5th February 2024

This week, the children will be focusing on a sound that you find at the end (a suffix) of some **adjectives**. **Please make sure that you know the meaning of each word and not just how to spell it.**

OUS

It is important that your child looks carefully at their spelling when they have written a word containing this sound, to decide if it *looks* right. This sound is written as 'ous' but it sounds like 'oos'. The 'ous' usually means 'full of' – dangerous, full of danger.

Examples:

enormous

fabulous

dangerous

jealous

famous

miraculous

ridiculous

generous

Challenge 1:

Work together to practise writing these words making sure that you select the correct letters for the sound.

Challenge 2:

Can you find any 'ous' words in your reading books and add them to your spelling practise?
